

Reconciliation & Eucharist Information

Diocesan Requirements:

- ▶ Candidates must be baptized Christians
- ▶ Candidates must express a desire to receive the sacrament to the pastor or his delegate
- ▶ Candidates and parents must attend Mass on a regular basis. A letter must be signed by the pastor of the church confirming attendance. See attached.
- ▶ Parents are expected to participate in all parent sessions and to share in the preparation process
- ▶ Candidate must be at least in the second grade
- ▶ Candidate must provide a certificate of Baptism
- ▶ Candidate must have been enrolled in a Catholic school or Parish Religious Education program for at least 1 year before beginning the process.

Dates to Remember:

January 21 – Meeting for parents of candidates preparing for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. 6:30 in the Cafeteria.

March 4 – 1st Reconciliation, 6:30 in the church

April 1 – Holy Thursday – Mass at 7:00

April 29 - Meeting for parents of candidates preparing for 1st Communion, 6:30 in the Cafeteria.

May 2 – Crowning of Mary, 10:30 Mass

May 15 – 9:00 Krug Hall – Parent & child are required to attend - Review of the prayers of the Liturgy and Sacraments of Initiation

May 22 - 9:00 Krug Hall – Parent & child are required to attend – Scriptural basis for the Sacrament of Eucharist

June 5 – 9:00, Church – Parent & child are required to attend – Practice for receiving First Communion.

June 6 – 10:30 Mass – First Communion
